# New Mexico Law

- **30-19-2(A). Gambling.**
- Gambling consists of:
  - A. making a bet;
- Whoever commits gambling is **guilty of a petty misdemeanor.**
  
- **30-19-3(B). Commercial gambling.**
- Commercial gambling consists of:
  - B. receiving, recording or forwarding bets or offers to bet;
- Whoever commits commercial gambling is **guilty of a fourth degree felony.**
  
- **30-19-8. Gambling and gambling houses as public nuisance.**
  - Except as otherwise permitted or excepted under this article any gambling device or gambling place is a **public nuisance per se.**
  
- **60-2E-4(A). Limited gaming activity permitted.**
- **Gaming activity is permitted** in New Mexico only if it is conducted in compliance with and pursuant to:
  - A. the Gaming Control Act;

## *Murphy v. NCAA*, Supreme Ct. No. 16–476.

- Professional & Amateur Sports Protection Act of 1992 (PASPA) prohibiting states from authorizing sports betting was ruled unconstitutional contrary to “anti-commandeering” doctrine of the 10th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.
- The “anti-commandeering” doctrine precludes Congress from ordering states to adopt a specific regulatory scheme when the federal government itself has not adopted a relevant scheme. PASPA didn’t create a federal standard for sports betting, but rather blocked 46 states from doing so under their own state laws.
- Supreme Court Held, “[C]ongress can regulate sports gambling directly, but if it elects not to do so, each State is free to act on its own.”
- Thus opening the door for New Mexico to create its own sports betting laws. [https://www.supremecourt.gov/opinions/17pdf/16-476\\_dbfi.pdf](https://www.supremecourt.gov/opinions/17pdf/16-476_dbfi.pdf)

# Class III Gaming

**25 U.S.C. § 2703(8)**

The term “class III gaming” means all forms of gaming that are not class I gaming or class II gaming.

**25 C.F.R. § 502.4(c)**

“ ... Any sports betting”

# Ways to Wager

- **The Spread** - The point spread is when the team you bet on must "cover the spread." This means the team must win or not lose by a predetermined margin of points.
- **Over-Under** - An over–under or over/under (O/U) bet is a wager in which a sportsbook will predict a number for a statistic in a given game (usually the combined score of the two teams), and bettors wager that the actual number in the game will be either higher or lower than that number.
- **The Straight Bet** - A person selects a team to win and places their wager. If your team wins the game, you win. The payout varies according to the odds posted.
