












What is TRiO? How Does Veterans Upward Bound Fit In?

## Federal Trio Programs

- ✓ Set of Educational Programs
- ✓ Established by the Higher Education Act of 1965
- ✓ Veterans Upward Bound added in 1972
- ✓ Purpose to enroll underrepresented populations into college programs
- ✓ Designed Primarily for First Generation College Students
- ✓ Also Intended for Low-income Students
- ✓ Other At~Risk Students

#### **Educational Opportunity Centers**

The <u>Educational Opportunity Centers Program</u> (EOC) is designed to provide support services to qualified adults, including veterans, who want to enter or continue a program of postsecondary education.

### **Student Support Services (SSS)**

Institutions of higher education provide opportunities for academic development, assist students with basic college requirements, and to motivate students toward the successful completion of their postsecondary education.




