

- Flexible Expeditionary Airfield Resources & Expertise
 - FGS-BEAR: Basic Expeditionary Airfield Resource (BEAR)
 - FGS-FSE: Fuels Operational Readiness Capability Equipment (FORCE)
- What is a BEAR Base?
 - Given a site with a usable runway, taxiway, parking areas, and a source of water that can be made potable, BEAR can provide billets, life support, fuels systems, and aircraft maintenance shelters to enable sortie generation.
- Supports CCDRs, USSTRATCOM, DSCA, HUMRO, and POTUS
- Leads Over 400 personnel across 34 AFSCs
- USAF's largest deployment commitment & largest container program
- In 2021, constructed 900-person camp in support of Operation ALLIES WELCOME in nine days











Airspace






- White Sands Missile Range Airspace is in high demand

- Extensive wait list (86)


