


# What it means to be diagnosed and treated at an NCI-designated comprehensive cancer center

## **Challenging Health and Socioeconomic Disparities**

- Per Capita Income: 48th
- 32/33 Counties: Medically Underserved
- 43%: Medicaid Waiver
- 8% 13%: Medically Uninsured
- 25% Patients:No Primary Care Provider

- To reduce New Mexico's cancer burden by discovering the genetic, environmental, social, and behavioral factors that contribute to the distinct patterns of cancer incidence, mortality, and disparity in our populations
  - Education, outreach and access to cancer prevention and screening program.






## Building for the Future
