

Security Screening

All visitors to the State Capitol are required to undergo a security screening.

- Visitors can choose to:
 - pass through the scanner; or
 - have security staff scan them using a wand.
- Credible assurance (proof) in the form of a medical device card or medical ID is not a reliable way to confirm that a visitor has a disability and does not exempt a person from going through security.
- If a visitor refuses all options for going through security, staff reserve the legal right to deny entrance.

There is no disability that justifies allowing members of the public to enter the State Capitol without going through security.
