

- ▶ To provide same day medical services including evenings and Saturdays (7 years).
- ▶ Uninsured patients forced into medical debt as existing systems unable to meet the needs.
- ▶ Clinicians wanted independence to practice values-based, holistic medicine.
- ▶ Clinicians wanted simplicity to focus on solving the complexity of illness and poverty.
