Pursuant to SM 77 passed during the 2013 Regular Legislative Session, the Regulation and Licensing Department (“RLD”) proposes the following with regard to the creation and implementation of a task force to undertake a comprehensive review of the Liquor Control Act and make recommendations to the Legislature regarding amendments to update the Liquor Control Act to better meet the needs of the public and respectfully requests the Economic and Rural Development Interim Committee’s (“Committee”) endorsement of the proposals contained herein, including the proposed makeup of the task force.

Prior to January 1, 2014 the Alcohol and Gaming Division (“AGD”) of RLD will appoint a task force and hold initial task force meetings around the state to take public comment and input on issues related to the Liquor Control Act. AGD will then compile those comments into a report and begin holding public meetings of the task force in Santa Fe to review public comment and come up with proposed legislation to present to the Committee in fall of 2014, as required by SM 77.

All task force meetings will be open to the public. If it be the will of the Committee, AGD will keep Monica Ewing updated regarding when and where task force meetings will occur so that she may notify Committee members. In addition, if the Committee would like a status update anytime between now and fall of 2014, the AGD Director would be happy to return and present to the Committee upon request.

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A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE REGULATION AND LICENSING DEPARTMENT TO CONVENE
A TASK FORCE TO ASSESS AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR UPDATING
THE LIQUOR CONTROL ACT.

WHEREAS, over three decades have passed since the Liquor
Control Act underwent a major review and reformation; and

WHEREAS, the public's needs have changed over the past
three decades with the advent of the electronic age,
modernized business practices and changes in social norms, and
an increase in alcohol awareness; and

WHEREAS, alcoholism and driving under the influence of
alcohol continue to threaten the state's health, safety,
welfare and morals; and

WHEREAS, promoting economic development while still
ensuring the public's health, safety, welfare and morals is of
the utmost importance for the legislature; and

WHEREAS, the alcohol and gaming division of the
regulation and licensing department is responsible for
administering the laws related to the issuance, sale and
transfer of new liquor licenses and alcohol server permits in
the state; and

WHEREAS, the special investigations division of the
department of public safety is currently responsible for
enforcing the complex laws related to the sale and service of

1 alcohol in the state; and

2 WHEREAS, law enforcement is intimately aware of the
3 issues related to the state's high rate of convictions for
4 driving under the influence;

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
6 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the regulation and licensing
7 department be requested to convene a task force to undertake a
8 comprehensive review of the Liquor Control Act and make
9 recommendations to the legislature regarding amendments to
10 update the Liquor Control Act to better meet the needs of the
11 public; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force include
13 representatives from industries covered by the Liquor Control
14 Act, including but not limited to hospitality, tourism,
15 restaurants, retailers, petroleum retailers, grocers, brewers
16 and distillers, wineries and wholesalers; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force include
18 representatives from any other groups that may have an
19 interest in amending the Liquor Control Act, including the DWI
20 resource center, mothers against drunk driving, the
21 New Mexico municipal league and the New Mexico association of
22 counties, as well as representatives from law enforcement, the
23 special investigations division of the department of public
24 safety, the alcohol and gaming division of the regulation and
25 licensing department, organizations involved with alcohol

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abuse prevention and underage drinking prevention and interested citizens; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force be geographically diverse to ensure that voices are heard from around the state; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force be requested to report its findings and recommendations to the appropriate legislative interim committees by November 1, 2014; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the superintendent of regulation and licensing, for distribution to members of the task force, and to the co-chairs of the New Mexico legislative council.
