ABEYANCE PENDING DISCOVERY**


THIS MATTER having come before the Court on October 4, 2012, for a hearing, Defendant Morris appearing through his attorney of record, ADAM D. RAFKIN, P.C. (Adam D. Rafkin, Esq.), Plaintiff appearing through its attorney, DAY PITNEY, LLP (Kenneth W. Ritt, Esq.), and the Court having heard argument of counsel, reviewed the pleadings and being

otherwise fully advised in the premises, FINDS that the Motion to Hold Proceedings in Abeyance is not well-taken and should therefore be denied, and the Motion to Dismiss is well-taken and should therefore be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Plaintiff's Motion to Hold Proceedings on Defendant Henry Morris' Motion to Dismiss in Abeyance Pending Discovery, be, and hereby is, denied.

2. That Defendant Morris' Motion to Dismiss Third Amended Complaint is dismissed as against Defendant Henry Morris based on lack of in personam jurisdiction.
