**SANTA FE** — The New Mexico Legislative Council is soliciting applications to fill a vacancy on the State Investment Council.

The person appointed by the legislative council must have at least 10 years of experience in the field of investment or finance and may not have had any contracts to do business with the State Investment Council, the Investment Office, the Office of the State Treasurer, the Educational Retirement Board, the Public Employees Retirement Association, the New Mexico Finance Authority or the State Board of Finance for two years prior to being appointed. The person appointed by the legislative council will fill the unexpired term of Michael Martin, who resigned.
