Work Plan

The Tobacco Settlement Revenue Oversight Committee (TSROC) was established pursuant to Section 2-19-1 NMSA 1978. The TSROC is tasked with monitoring the use of tobacco settlement revenue, reviewing evaluations of programs receiving funding from tobacco settlement revenue and making recommendations for program funding and for changes in legislation regarding the use of tobacco settlement revenue.

In addition to its statutory duties, and as time permits, during the 2026 interim, the TSROC will address the following topics:

- A. updates from agencies receiving funds;
- B. vaping legislation;
- C. retail tobacco licensing;
- D. funding enforcement through the Regulation and Licensing Department;
- E. progress of the Nicotine Use Prevention and Control Program through the Department of Health;
- F. review of available funds;
- G. review of the Attorney General settlement;
- H. counterfeit vapes;
- I. smoking deterrence;
- J. nicotine use in schools;
- K. packaging and flavors of vapes;

- L. Juul settlement funds;
- M. preparation of recommendations to the Legislative Finance Committee for program funding levels based on that committee's program evaluation process; and
- N. make findings and recommendations, including proposed legislation, available to the legislature as part of the TSROC's final report.
