The program is for New Mexico students attending New Mexico schools, and New Mexico residents attending nearby colleges and universities.

Interns work directly for one of the legislature's three nonpartisan staff agencies. Interns work with experienced legislative staff members, legislators, committees, state agencies and the public.

Work performed may include legal and policy analysis, issues analysis, speech writing, budget analysis and committee staffing.
