## **SUMMARY**

### Synopsis of Bill

HB 187 appropriates \$200.0 from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in FY 01 for the purpose of planning and designing a baseball field and infrastructure improvements to Gaeto fields in Albuquerque for flood migration and compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

### Significant Issues

HB 187 does not specify who owns Gaeto fields. If the fields are privately owned , a problem may exist with the anti-donation clause.

## **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

House Bill 187 appropriates \$200.0 from general fund.

## **TECHNICAL ISSUES**

HB187 appropriates from the general fund and since the purpose of the fund is for capital improvements, it may be more appropriate to utilize severance tax bonds for the project.
