## SUMMARY

## Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 140 prohibits certain abortion procedures and sets out penalties for those who perform these procedures. The bill also defines who may bring a cause of action for civil remedy and also defines the degree of criminal penalty for those found guilty under this act.
