FISCAL IMPLICATIONS	
This bill appropriates \$145.0 in general fund.	
ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS	
CD reports the administrative impact would be minimal.

TECHNICAL ISSUES
CD indicates SB204 should specify what juveniles are to be served by the bill.
The Juvenile Parole Board indicates juvenile facilities are not under CD but under CYFD. Funding may have to be separate or divided between the two agencies.
OTHER SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES
CD reports they have no authority over juveniles being supervised by CYFD, CD would have no way of implementing counseling for juveniles outside the adult facilities.
CD suggests specifying that CD is only responsible for those juveniles who are incarcerated in the department's correctional facilities and not those juveniles supervised by CYFD.
