A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE STATE INVESTMENT COUNCIL, THE LEGISLATIVE
FINANCE COMMITTEE AND THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY
COMMITTEE TO PARTICIPATE WITH THE EDUCATION INITIATIVES AND
ACCOUNTABILITY TASK FORCE IN A STUDY OF POLICIES TO ENSURE
THAT PUBLIC SCHOOL SUPPORT RETAINS THE PROPORTION OF GENERAL
TAX REVENUES AT FISCAL YEAR 1999 LEVELS.

WHEREAS, a reliable source of revenue is vital to New
Mexico's schools; and

WHEREAS, three hundred thirty thousand three hundred
seventy-two children need the highest quality public schools
possible; and

WHEREAS, our permanent funds are our funding for the
future; and

WHEREAS, our children are our future;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE

1 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state investment council, the
2 legislative finance committee and the legislative education
3 study committee be requested to participate with the
4 education initiatives and accountability task force in a
5 study of the statutory and constitutional mechanisms to
6 ensure that public school support retains the proportion of
7 general tax revenues at fiscal year 1999 levels so that
8 additional earnings from the land grant permanent fund are
9 real increases in funding; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study recommend
11 statutory and constitutional mechanisms to maximize and
12 enhance support for public school capital outlay from the
13 severance tax permanent fund and maximize and enhance funding
14 increases from the land grant permanent fund; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force report its
16 recommendations to the legislature in time for the 2001
17 legislative session; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
19 transmitted to members of the state investment council, the
20 legislative finance committee, the legislative education
21 study committee and the education initiatives and
22 accountability task force.
