NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to direct the appropriate interim committee to consider creation of the office of a state climatologist, which would assess the effect of climate on the natural environment, agricultural production, land and natural resources and human health, and make recommendations on key issues such as financing the collection and dissemination of climatic information to educate the national population and the tourist industry about the healthy and unique climate of New Mexico that makes the state not only an exemplary place to live and visit, but also an ideal place to locate industry and associated jobs; and
