e	elderly", also called PACE, provides acute, primary and long-
	term care and social and support services to frail elders who
	qualify for nursing facility placement, but prefer to remain
	in their own homes; and
	WHEREAS, PACE services allow participants to stay in
	their homes; and
	WHEREAS, a PACE program known as St. Joseph senior care
	is successfully providing services to up to three hundred
	fifty frail elders in Albuquerque; and
	WHEREAS, PACE programs provide comprehensive health and
	long-term care services at lower cost than can nursing homes;
	and
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1	WHEREAS, the frail elderly consortium, in its efforts to
2	develop innovative home and community-based alternatives to
3	traditional institutional long-term care, supports the
4	creation of a rural PACE program;
5	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
6	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the human services department be
7	requested to initiate a PACE program in a rural community of
8	New Mexico within fiscal year 2001; and
