11 REQUESTING THE STATE PARKS DIVISION OF THE ENERGY, MINERALS  
12 AND NATURAL RESOURCES DEPARTMENT TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF  
13 AND ASSIST THE DEVELOPMENT OF MASTER FACILITY PLANS FOR THE  
14 DONA ANA EDUCATIONAL CAMP AND RECREATIONAL PARK IN CHAPARRAL  
15 IN DONA ANA COUNTY.

17 WHEREAS, at-risk youth benefit from educational and  
18 recreational experiences in the outdoors; and

19 WHEREAS, the Dona Ana educational camp and recreational  
20 park near the community of Chaparral is being planned as a  
21 facility to provide alternatives for youth; and

22 WHEREAS, the facility may serve as a model for other  
23 outdoor experiences for youth throughout the state;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE  
25 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state parks division of the  
energy, minerals and natural resources department be  
requested to conduct a feasibility study and help develop a
