BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 66-6-15 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 350) is amended to read:
" 66-6-15. VEHI CLES OF THE STATE, COUNTY OR MUNI CI PALI TY. --
A. Vehicles or trailers owned by and used in the service of this state, an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo l ocated wholly or partly in this state or of any county or muni ci pality of this state need not be regi stered but must continually di splay plates furni shed by the di vi sion.
B. Vehi cles on Ioan from deal ers and used in an approved driver-trai ni ng programby the public schools need not be regi stered but must continually display plates furni shed by the di vi sion.
C. Each state department or agency, each I ndi an nation, tribe or puebl o, each county and each munici pality shall apply to the division for a plate for each vehicle or trailer in its service and shall provide identifying information concerning each vehicle or trailer for which a plate is applied for.

D. The di vision shall issue pl ates for vehicles and trailers in the service of this state, an Indian nation, tribe or pueblolocated wholly or partly in this state or of any county or mini cipality of this state and keep a record of pl ates i ssued and pl ates returned. The pl ates shall be permanent and need not be renewed from year to year. The plates shall be numbered to identify the state department or agency, the Indi an nation, tribe or puebl o, the county or the muni ci pality to which the pl ates are issued. The pl ates shall be the same size as regi stration plates issued to private vehicles but shall be different in col or fromthe regi stration pl ates issued to private vehicles."

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, heal $t h$ and safety that $t$ his act take effect i mmedi at el $y$.
