AN ACT
RELATI NG TO GAM NG; AMENDI NG THE GAM NG CONTROL ACT TO PROVI DE FOR GAM NG MACH NES THAT ACCEPT CURRENCY; DECLARI NG AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 60-2E-44 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws
1997, Chapter 190, Section 46) is amended to read:
"60-2E-44. MACHI NE SPECI FI CATI ONS. - - To be el igi ble for licensure, each gaming machi ne shall meet all specifications establ ished by regul ations of the board and:
A. be unable to be mani pul ated in a manner that affects the random probability of winning pl ays or in any ot her manner determined by the board to be undesi rable;
B. have at least one mechani smthat accepts coins or currency;
C. be capable of having pl ay suspended through the central system by the executive director until he resets the gaming machi ne;
D. house nonresettable mechani cal and el ectronic meters within a readily accessi ble locked area of the gaming machi ne that mai ntain a permant record of all money inserted into the machi ne, all cash payouts of wi nni ngs, all ref unds of wi nni ngs, all credits played for additional games and all credits won by players;
E. be capable of printing out, at the request of
the executive di rector, readi ngs on the el ectronic meters of the machi ne;
F. for machi nes that do not di spense coins or tokens di rectly to players, be capable of printing a ticket voucher stating the val ue of a cash prize won by the player at the completion of each game, the date and time of day the game was played in a twenty-four-hour format showing hours and minutes, the machi ne serial number, the sequential number of the ticket voucher and an encrypted val idation number for determing the validity of a wi nning ticket voucher;
G. be capable of being linked to the board's central systemfor the purpose of being monitored continuously as requi red by the board;
H. provi de for a payback val ue for each credit wagered, determined over time, of not less than ei ghty percent or more than ni nety-six percent;
I. meet the standards and specifications set by I aws or regul ations of the states of Nevada and New Jersey for gaming machi nes, whi chever are more stringent;
J. offer onl y games authorized and exami ned by the board; and
K. di spl ay the gaming machi ne license i ssued for that machi ne in an easily accessible place, before and
during the time that a machi ne is available for use."

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
peace, heal th and safety that this act take effect
i meedi at el $y$.
