AN ACT
RELATI NG TO MDTOR VEHI CLE REGI STRATI ON; I NCLUDI NG CERTAI N GOVERNMENTS I N THE DI STRI BUTI ON OF GOVERNMENT LI CENSE PLATES; DECLARI NG AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 66-6-15 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1978, Chapt er 35, Section 350) is amended to read:
"66-6-15. VEHI CLES OF THE STATE, COUNTY OR MUNI CI PALI TY. - -
A. Vehi cles or trailers owned by and used in the servi ce of [the] this state [ of New Mexice], an I ndi an nation, tribe or pueblolocated wholly or partly in this state or of any county or muni ci pality [thereof] of this state need not be regi stered but must continually display plates furni shed by the di vi sion.

B. Vehi cles on I oan from deal ers and used in an approved driver-trai ning program by the public schools need not be regi stered but must continually di splay pl ates [funi-shed] furni shed by the di vi sion.
C. Each state department or agency, each Indi an nation, tribe or puebl o, each county and each muni ci pality shall apply to the di vision for alate for each vehicle or trailer in [their] its service and shall provide identifying information concerning each vehicle or trailer for which a pl ate is applied for.
D. The di visi on shall issue plates for vehi cl es and trailers in the service of [the] this state, an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo located wholly or partly in this state or of any county or municipality [thereof] of this state and keep a record of pl ates i ssued and pl ates returned. [Such] The plates shall be per manent and need not be [ z ] renewed from year to year. [Such] The plates shall be number ed to identify the state department or agency, the I ndi an nation, tribe or puebl o, the county or the munici pality to whi ch the plates are issued. [Such] The plates shall be the same size as registration pl ates issued to private vehicles but shall be different incol or from the regi stration pl ates i ssued to private vehicles."

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, heal $t h$ and safet $y$ that $t h i s$ act take effect imedi atel $y$.
