16	Section 1. A new section of the New Mexico Insurance

18	"59A-22-42. [ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION
19	CONTRACEPTIVE DRUGS OR DEVICES
20	A. Each individual and group health insurance
21	policy, health care plan and certificate of health insurance
22	delivered or issued for delivery in this state, and which
23	offers a prescription drug benefit, shall offer coverage for
24	prescription contraceptive drugs or devices approved by the
25	food and drug administration.

C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to short-term travel, accident-only or limited or specifieddisease policies."

"59A-23-4. OTHER PROVISIONS APPLICABLE. --

A. No blanket or group health insurance policy or contract shall contain any provision relative to notice or proof of loss or the time for paying benefits or the time within which suit may be brought upon the policy that in the superintendent's opinion is less favorable to the insured than would be permitted in the required or optional provisions for individual health insurance policies as set forth in Chapter 59A, Article 22 NMSA 1978.

B. The following provisions of Chapter 59A, Article 22 NMSA 1978 shall also apply as to Chapter 59A, Article 23 NMSA 1978 and blanket and group health insurance . 133956.1

OTHER PROVISIONS APPLICABLE. -- The provisions of the Insurance Code other than Chapter 59A, Article 47 NMSA 1978 shall not apply to health care plans except as expressly provided in the Insurance Code and that article. To the extent reasonable and not inconsistent with the provisions of that article, the following articles and provisions of the Insurance Code shall also apply to health care plans, their promoters, sponsors, directors, officers, employees, agents, solicitors and other representatives; and, for the purposes of such applicability, a health care plan may therein be referred to as an "insurer":
