AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY FOR VARIOUS WATER-RELATED RESEARCH AND CONSERVATION PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. - -

One million five hundred thirty-eight thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,538,800) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for expenditure in fiscal year 2002 in the following amounts for the following purposes:

- six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) (1) for the water resources research institute to conduct research on aquatic species;
- **(2)** one hundred thirty-eight thousand one hundred sixty dollars (\$138,160) for the agricultural . 133361. 1

experiment station to conduct science-based water use education and research programs for best management practices;

- (3) three hundred thousand six hundred forty dollars (\$300,640) for the cooperative extension service to conduct science-based water use education and research programs for best management practices; and
- (4) five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for soil and water conservation districts to carry out best management practice watershed management and restoration projects by providing technical and financial incentives to landowners.
- B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the general fund.
