15	Section 1. Section 1-12-42 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969,
16	Chapter 240, Section 302) is amended to read:
17	"1-12-42. CONDUCT OF ELECTIONEMPLOYEESTIME TO
18	VOTE.
19	A. On election day [any] <u>a</u> voter may absent
20	himself from employment in which he is engaged for two hours
21	for the purpose of voting between the time of opening and the
22	time of closing the polls. The voter shall not be liable to
23	any penalty for such absence; however, the employer may
24	specify the hours during this period in which the voter may be
25	absent.

1	B. The provisions of Subsection A of this section
2	do not apply to [any] <u>an</u> employee whose work day begins more
3	than two hours subsequent to the time of opening the polls, or
4	ends more than three hours prior to the time of closing the
5	polls.
6	<u>C. The provisions of Subsection A of this section</u>
7	<u>apply to elections of Indian nations, tribes or pueblos for a</u>
8	voter who is enrolled as a member of the Indian nation, tribe
9	or pueblo and is qualified to vote in the election.
10	[C. Any] <u>D. A</u> person [or corporation] who refuses
11	the right granted in this section to [any] <u>an</u> employee is
12	guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not
13	less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one hundred
14	dollars (\$100)."
