(2) there are many homes in rural areas running out of propane because trucks cannot reach their homes on the snow packed roads;

(3) there are thousands of cattle stranded and facing starvation;

- (5) state expenditures are necessary to provide those resources and services necessary to avoid or minimize economic or physical harm until the situation becomes stabilized and again under local self-support and control.
- B. Seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 2001 to take any action necessary to alleviate the emergency situation in Mora county, including expenditures on a temporary, emergency basis for lodging, sheltering, health care, food, snow removal, any transportation or shipping necessary to protect lives or public property; or for any other action necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2001 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
