(5) four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for Torrance county; and

(6) four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for Santa Fe county.

Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2001 shall revert to the general fund.".
