drilling fluids, produced waters, petroleum liquids or
petroleum sludges.

The solid waste facility may accept nondomestic 3 **B**. 4 waste for disposal with the approval of the oil conservation division of the energy, minerals and natural resources 5 department pursuant to its authority under the Oil and Gas Act 6 7 if the nondomestic waste otherwise meets the requirements of the Solid Waste Act applicable to the solid waste facility. 8 Upon presentation for disposal, nondomestic waste shall be 9 10 regulated in the same manner as solid waste for purposes of 11 the Solid Waste Act."

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
