<u>A.</u> The county sheriffs shall be reimbursed for the actual expense incurred for the care and feeding of <u>state</u> prisoners in transit. [No] <u>A</u> reimbursement shall <u>not</u> be made [<u>under</u>] <u>pursuant to</u> this section without proof of actual expenses incurred by a sheriff or his delegate. In no event shall the reimbursement for any prisoner exceed the rate set by the Per Diem and Mileage Act.

B. A county shall be reimbursed by the state for not more than fifty percent of the actual expenses incurred for the care and feeding of state prisoners in transit. Notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection, counties with one hundred thousand persons or more, as determined by the 2000 United States census, shall not cumulatively receive . 135736.1

Section 3. A new Section 4-44-20.1 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"4-44-20.1. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] CAP ON THE AMOUNT OF STATE REIMBURSEMENT TO COUNTIES FOR THE EXPENSE OF EXTRADITING, TRANSPORTING AND FEEDING STATE PRISONERS.--

A. For fiscal year 2003, the total amount of the reimbursement by the state to counties for the cost of extraditing, transporting and feeding state prisoners, as provided in Sections 4-44-18 and 4-44-20 NMSA 1978, shall not exceed one million dollars (\$1,000,000).

B. For fiscal year 2004 and subsequent fiscal years, the total amount of the reimbursement by the state to counties for the cost of extraditing, transporting and feeding state prisoners, as provided in Sections 4-44-18 and 4-44-20 NMSA 1978, shall not exceed one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000)."

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2002.
