HOUSE BILL 549

AN ACT

RELATING TO MUNICIPAL ANNEXATION; REQUIRING AGREEMENT OF A
MAJORITY OF A TERRITORY'S RESIDENTS BEFORE THE MUNICIPAL
BOUNDARY COMMISSION MAY ORDER ANNEXATION OF THE TERRITORY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 3-7-15 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1965, Chapter 300, Section 14-7-15) is amended to read:

"3-7-15. DUTIES OF THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY COMMISSION-AUTHORITY OF COMMISSION TO ANNEX--ORDER IS FINAL--REVIEW BY
CERTIORARI.--

A. At the public hearing held for the purpose of determining if the territory proposed to be annexed to the municipality shall be annexed to the municipality, the municipal boundary commission shall determine if the territory proposed to be annexed:

1	(1) is contiguous to the municipality; [and]
2	(2) may be provided with municipal services
3	by the municipality to which the territory is proposed to be
4	annexed; <u>and</u>

8	that the conditions set forth in this section are met, the
9	commission [shall] <u>may</u> order annexed to the municipality the
