AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING NECESSARY FULL-DAY KINDERGARTEN CLASSROOMS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Fifteen million three hundred fifty-four thousand dollars (\$15,354,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 2002 to plan, design and construct full-day kindergarten classrooms throughout the state. The money shall be apportioned by the state department of public education in the following amounts to the following school districts for the following schools:

(1) six million three hundred two thousand

dollars (\$6,302,000) to the Albuquerque public school district for full-day kindergarten classrooms at A. C. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from any of the appropriations in this section at the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2001.
