RELATING TO ELECTIONS; LOWERING THE THRESHOLD REQUIRING POLITICAL COMMITTEES TO REGISTER WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 1-19-26.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 46, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

POLITICAL COMMITTEES--REGISTRATION--"1-19-26.1. DISCLOSURES. --

It is unlawful for any political committee that receives, contributes or expends in excess of [two thousand dollars (\$2,000) five hundred dollars (\$500) in any calendar year to continue to receive or make any contribution or expenditure for a political purpose unless that political committee appoints and maintains a treasurer and registers with the secretary of state.

B. A political committee shall register with the
secretary of state within ten days of receiving, contributing
or expending in excess of [two thousand dollars (\$2,000)] <u>five</u>
hundred dollars (\$500) by paying a filing fee of fifty dollars
(\$50.00) and filing a statement of organization under oath on
a prescribed form showing:

- (1) the full name of the political committee, which shall fairly and accurately reflect the identity of the committee, including any sponsoring organization, and its address:
- (2) a statement of the purpose for which the political committee was organized;
- (3) the name, address and relationship of any connected or associated organization or entity;
- (4) the names and addresses of the officers of the committee: and
- (5) an identification of the bank used by the committee for all expenditures or contributions made or received.
- C. The provisions of this section do not apply to a political committee that is located in another state and is registered with the federal election commission if the political committee reports on federal reporting forms filed with the federal election commission all expenditures for and contributions made to reporting individuals in New Mexico and
