Any contractor who fails to indicate his B. contractor's license number clearly on all written bids and when applying for a building permit or who fails to make the disclosure statement required under this section shall be assessed by the division a penalty fee of [one hundred fifty dollars (\$150)] one thousand dollars (\$1,000). The fee shall be payable to the code jurisdiction or political subdivision which issued the permit or in which the work for which the bid is submitted is or would be permitted."
