AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PAY THE SETTLEMENT COSTS OF FALLS ET AL. V. SALISBURY AND THE COSTS RELATED TO THE ACQUISITION OF THE REMAINING PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE PETROGLYPH NATIONAL MONUMENT: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Five million dollars (\$5,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal years 2001 and 2002 to pay the settlement costs of Falls et al. v. Salisbury and the costs related to the acquisition of the remaining private property within the state's portion of the petroglyph national monument. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the general fund.
