19	1978 may be cited as the "Juvenile Parole Board Act"."
20	Section 2. Section 32A-7-7 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,
21	Chapter 77, Section 200) is amended to read:
22	"32A-7-7. COMPENSATIONThe members of the juvenile
23	parole board shall receive per diem and mileage as provided
24	for nonsalaried public officers in the Per Diem and Mileage
25	Act and shall receive [no other compensation, perquisite or
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1	allowance] ten dollars (\$10.00) for each case reviewed that
2	has been scheduled for a parole hearing."
3	Section 3. APPROPRIATIONThirty-five thousand dollars
4	(\$35,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
5	juvenile parole board for expenditure in fiscal year 2002 to
6	provide compensation for juvenile parole board members to
7	review cases pursuant to the provisions of Section 32A-7-7
8	NMSA 1978. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
9	at the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the general
10	fund.
11	Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
12	provisions of this act is July 1, 2001.
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
