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parole board, including one day of per diem for the review of

Section 3. APPROPRIATION. -- Twenty-three thousand four hundred dollars (\$23,400) is appropriated from the general fund to the juvenile parole board for expenditure in fiscal year 2002 to provide additional per diem to juvenile parole board members for performing their official duties as set forth in Section 32A-7-7 NMSA 1978. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2001.

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
