C. develop procedures for the funding of the second statue and raise funds to commission the design, creation and transport of a statue to be placed in the national statuary hall through the creation of a foundation for the acceptance of gifts, donations, bequests and proceeds from appropriate fundraising events in accordance with the 7 provisions of the act of July 2, 1864 (40 U.S.C. 187); and [D. commission the design and creation of a statue 8 9 of the illustrious San Juan pueblo Indian strategist and 10 warrior Popé, who was renowned, respected and revered by the Native Americans of New Mexico as the leader of the pueblo revolt of 1680 and who would be the second Native American to be honored with placement of a statue in the national statuary
