AN ACT

RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS; REQUIRING PUBLIC REGULATION

COMMISSION APPROVAL OF CERTAIN CHANGE OF CONTROL TRANSACTIONS;

ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY

CERTIFICATION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Telephone and Telegraph Company Certification Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] PRIOR APPROVAL OF COMMISSION REQUIRED OF CERTAIN CHANGE OF CONTROL TRANSACTIONS--DEFINITIONS--PROCEDURES FOR OBTAINING APPROVAL.--

A. As used in this section:

(1) "change of control transaction" means an action taken by a telecommunications entity that has the effect of allowing or facilitating an acquisition,

consolidation, merger or other transaction involving another telecommunications entity that would alter the manner in which plant or property constituting an operating unit or system or any substantial part of either was controlled, held or owned;

- (2) "public telecommunications service" means the transmission of signs, signals, writings, images, sounds, messages, data or other information of any nature by wire, radio, lightwaves or other electromagnetic means originating and terminating in this state regardless of actual call routing, but "public telecommunications service" does not include the provision of terminal equipment used to originate or terminate such service; private telecommunications service; broadcast transmissions by radio, television and satellite broadcast stations regulated by the federal communications commission; radio common carrier services, including mobile telephone service and radio paging; or one-way cable television service:
- (3) "telecommunications company" means a person that provides public telecommunications service and a cellular service company as defined in Subsection B of Section 63-9B-3 NMSA 1978; and
- (4) "telecommunications entity" means a telephone company as defined in Section 63-9-2 NMSA 1978, a telecommunications company or a holding company, parent company, subsidiary or affiliate of a telephone company or a

telecommunications company.

- B. With the prior express authorization of the commission, but not otherwise:
- (1) two or more telecommunications entities may acquire, consolidate or merge with each other;
- (2) a person and a telecommunications entitymay consolidate or merge with each other;
- (3) stock of a telecommunications entity may be acquired by:
- (a) a person who, prior to the acquisition of the stock, is a person subject to regulation by the commission or is classified as a telecommunications entity in any jurisdiction;
- (b) a person who is or during the course of an acquisition covered by this section becomes subject to regulation by the commission or is classified as a telecommunications entity in any jurisdiction based on reasons other than solely the acquisition described in this subparagraph;
- (c) a person associated, affiliated or acting in concert with a person subject to regulation by the commission or classified as a telecommunications entity in any jurisdiction for the purposes of an acquisition subject to the provisions of this section;
 - (d) a person associated, affiliated or

acting in concert with a person described in Subparagraph (a), (b) or (c) of this paragraph; or

- (e) a person who, during the course of an acquisition covered by this section, merges or consolidates with a person described in Subparagraph (a), (b) or (c) of this paragraph; or
- (4) a telecommunications entity may sell, lease, rent, purchase or acquire a telecommunications entity's plant or property constituting part or all of an operating unit or system, but this paragraph does not require commission authorization for transactions in the ordinary course of business.
- C. A change of control transaction undertaken without the prior express approval of the commission is void.
- D. A telecommunications entity seeking approval of the commission as required by this section shall file written petition with the commission containing a concise statement of the proposed change of control transaction, the reasons for it and other information that may reasonably be required by the commission. The commission promptly shall investigate the statements in the petition and may require a hearing on the application in which case adequate notice of the hearing shall be prescribed by the commission. After considering the allegations of the petition, the benefits and fairness of the proposed transaction to the ratepayers and other matters

deemed relevant by the commission, it shall approve or disapprove the application. It may impose requirements to further the benefits to the ratepayers as a condition of approval."
