MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAMS NOT PROVIDED BY MEDICAID.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. - -

One million two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1, 250, 000) is appropriated from the general fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2002 in the following amounts for the following purposes:

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (1) (\$750,000) to the children, youth and families department to contract for services and programs not provided under medicaid, including intensive outpatient programs, schoolbased services, outpatient clinics, wrap-around services, mobile crisis teams, early childhood family-based prevention, . 133909. 1
