- "F. Any candidate who fails or refuses to return any money to the fund as required by the Public Campaign Finance Option Act shall not, in addition to any other penalties provided by law:
- (1) have his name printed upon the ballot if the violation occurs before and through the final date for the withdrawal of candidates; or
- (2) be issued a certificate of nomination or election, if the violation occurs after the final date for withdrawal of candidates or after the election, until the candidate returns all money required to be returned pursuant to the Public Campaign Finance Option Act and pays all penalties owed."".
- 4. On page 12, line 2, strike "publish guidelines" and insert in lieu thereof "issue rules".
