AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO PROVIDE INTENSIVE COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES FOR AT-RISK YOUTH AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS IN THE SOUTH BROADWAY AREA OF ALBUQUERQUE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Two hundred forty-two thousand dollars (\$242,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 2002 to provide intensive community-based services for at-risk youth and community members in the south Broadway area of Albuquerque. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the general fund.
