SENATE BILL 170

AN ACT

RELATING TO MAGISTRATE COURTS; MAKING THE SAN JON CIRCUIT
COURT A FULL-TIME MAGISTRATE COURT; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 35-1-23 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1968, Chapter 62, Section 25, as amended) is amended to read:

"35-1-23. MAGISTRATE COURT--QUAY DISTRICT.--There shall be [one magistrate] two magistrates in Quay magistrate district, [whose principal court is in] division 1 in Tucumcari [The magistrate shall ride circuit to] and division 2 in San Jon [on a regularly scheduled basis]."

Section 2. TEMPORARY PROVISION -- APPOINTMENT -- ELECTION. --

A. The office of magistrate in Quay magistrate district division 2 shall be filled by appointment by the governor to begin serving on July 1, 2001. The appointed . 135272.1

magistrate shall serve until his successor has been elected and qualified.

B. The first full term of office of the magistrate in Quay magistrate district division 2 shall be filled by election at the general election held in 2002, and that term of office shall begin on January 1, 2003.

Section 3. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thirty-eight thousand dollars (\$138,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the administrative office of the courts for expenditure in fiscal year 2002 to pay salaries and benefits of the Quay magistrate district division 2 magistrate and staff. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2001.
