AN ACT

**RELATING TO LIQUOR SALES; PROHIBITING A PERSON FROM CONSUMING
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WHILE ON DUTY AS AN EMPLOYEE OF A LIQUOR
LICENSEE.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**Section 1. A new section of the Liquor Control Act is
enacted to read:**

**" [NEW MATERIAL] OFFENSE BY EMPLOYEE OF LICENSEE--
CONSUMING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WHILE WORKING-- DISORDERLY
CONDUCT. --**

**A. It is a violation of the Liquor Control Act for
a licensee, lessee or an employee of a licensee or lessee to
consume alcoholic beverages while mixing, pouring, serving,
selling or delivering alcoholic beverages to a customer or at
any time during the course of his shift of employment.**
