In addition to the requirements specified in 6 7 Subsection A of this section, the state board shall require that a person seeking standard or alternative elementary 8 9 certification shall have completed six hours of reading 10 courses, and a person seeking standard or alternative secondary certification shall have completed three hours of 11 12 reading courses in subject matter content. 13 [B.] C. The state board shall require, prior to 14 certification. no less than fourteen weeks of student 15

teaching, a portion of which shall occur in the first thirty credit hours taken in the college of education and shall be under the direct supervision of a certified school instructor and a portion of which shall occur in the student's senior year with the student teacher being directly responsible for the classroom.

[C.] D. Nothing in this section shall preclude the state board from establishing or accepting equivalent requirements for purposes of reciprocal certification or minimum requirements for alternative certification.
