4	Section 2. A new Section 10-11-27.1 NMSA 1978 is enacted
5	to read:
6	"10-11-27.1. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] LEGISLATIVE FINDINGSThe
7	legislature finds that:
8	A. it is appropriate to recognize the
9	professionalism and dedication of state police officers, who
10	provide an essential service to the citizens of New Mexico;
11	B. it is appropriate to recognize the hazardous
12	nature of the work performed by state police officers;
13	C. the spirit of what it takes to be a state
14	police officer is personified by Sergeant Brent H. Bateman,
15	who served with honor as a state police officer for twenty-two
16	years. Sergeant Bateman became ill days after his retirement
17	and passed away a short six months following retirement; and
18	D. the twenty percent credit towards actual
19	service provided in state police member coverage plan 1 is
20	dedicated to Sergeant Brent H. Bateman and all other officers
21	who have served, and who do serve, as New Mexico state police
22	officers."
