- "[NEW MATERIAL] COVERAGE FOR MEDICAL DIETS FOR INBORN ERRORS OF METABOLISM -- As of July 1, 2001, each health maintenance organization that delivers or issues for delivery in the state an individual or group contract shall provide coverage for the treatment of inborn errors of metabolism as set forth in Chapter 59A, Article 22 NMSA 1978."

Section 4. A new section of Chapter 59A, Article 47 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] COVERAGE FOR MEDICAL DIETS FOR INBORN ERRORS OF METABOLISM -- As of July 1, 2001, subscriber contracts of a health care plan shall also be subject to coverage for medical diets for inborn errors of metabolism as required of health insurers in Chapter 59A, Article 22 NMSA 1978."".
