11 RELATING TO TIME; EXEMPTING NEW MEXICO FROM OBSERVATION OF
12 DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 Section 1. STANDARD TIME-- DEFINITION-- OBSERVANCE. --

16 A. The standard time of New Mexico is standard
17 time based on the mean solar time of the one hundred fifth
18 degree of longitude west of Greenwich, commonly known as
19 mountain standard time.

20 B. New Mexico hereby exempts itself from the
21 provisions of the federal Uniform Time Act of 1966 providing
22 for the advancement of time. The entire state, including all
23 of its political subdivisions, shall throughout the year
24 observe standard time as defined in Subsection A of this
25 section.
