AN ACT
RELATI NG TO GAM NG; AMENDI NG THE GAM NG CONTROL ACT TO PROVI DE FOR GAM NG MACH NES THAT ACCEPT CURRENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 60-2E- 44 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997, Chapter 190, Section 46) is amended to read:
"60-2E-44. MACHI NE SPECI FI CATI ONS. - - To be el igi ble for Iicensure, each gaming machi ne shall meet all specifications established by regul ations of the board and:
A. be unable to be mani pul at ed in a manner that affects the randomprobability of winning plays or in any ot her manner determined by the board to be undesi rable;
B. have at least one mechani smthat accepts coins or currency [but does not accept bills of denomi nations greater than twenty dollars (\$20.00)];

C. be capable of having play suspended through the central system by the executive director until he resets the gaming machi ne;
D. house nonresettable mechanical and el ectronic meters within a readily accessi ble locked area of the gaming machi ne that mai ntain a permanent record of all money inserted into the machi ne, all cash payouts of wi nni ngs, all ref unds of wi nni ngs, all credits played for additional games and al I credits won by players;
E. be capable of printing out, at the request of the executi ve di rector, readi ngs on the el ectronic meters of the machi ne;
F. for machi nes that do not di spense coi ns or tokens di rectly to players, be capable of printing a ticket voucher stating the val ue of a cash prize won by the player at the compl et i on of each game, the date and time of day the gane was played in a twenty-four-hour format showing hours and minutes, the machi ne serial number, the sequential number of the ticket voucher and an encrypted validation number for determining the validity of a winn ng ticket voucher;
G. be capable of being linked to the board's central systemfor the pur pose of being monitored continuously as requi red by the board;
H. provide for a payback val ue for each credit wager ed, deter min over time, of not less than ei ghty percent . 136593. 1
or more than ni nety-si $x$ percent;
I. meet the standards and specifications set by I aws or regul ations of the states of Nevada and New Jersey for gaming machi nes, whi chever are more stringent;
J. offer onl $y$ games authorized and examined by the board; and
K. display the gaming machi ne license issued for that machi ne in an easily accessible place, bef ore and during the time that a machine is available for use."
