RELATI NG TO LAW ENFORCEMENT; REVI SI NG THE CRI TERI A FOR ADM SSI ON TO THE RADI O DI SPATCHER TRAI NI NG PROGRAM AMENDI NG A SECTI ON OF THE POLI CE RADI O DI SPATCHER TRAI NI NG ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 29-7A- 2 NNSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1979, Chapter 228, Section 2) is amended to read:
" 29-7A- 2. QUALI FI CATI ONS FOR ADM SSI ON [ FO THE TRAI NI NG AND EDUCATION BUREAU]. - - The [ chief] di rector of the New Mexico Iaw enforcement academy shall determine that all applicants for admission to the radio di spatcher training program[ of the training and education bureau of the criminal justice department]:
A. are citizens or legal perment residents of the United States and have reached the age of majority; . 136673. 1
B. hol d hi gh school di pl omas or the equi val ent;
C. have not been convi cted of a fel ony or ot her crime invol ving moral turpitude as determined by submission of the applicant's fingerprints to the [technical-services bureau of the criminal justice department] New Mexi co state police and to the [FB+] federal bureau of investigation identification di vision and by such ot her investigations as requi red by the applicant's place of empl oyment; and
D. are free of any physical, emotional or mental condition [hech] that mint adversel y affect thei $r$ performance. "

Section 2. EFFECTI VE DATE. - - The effective date of the provi sions of this act is July 1, 2001.
