RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES FOR RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL GUARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 66-3-413 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1980, Chapter 45, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-3-413. SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES. --

Α. The division shall issue distinctive registration plates to any person who is a member of or retired from the New Mexico national guard, upon the submission by the person of proof satisfactory to the division that he is [currently] a current or retired member of the No fee shall be collected for issuance of a special guard. registration plate for active members pursuant to this section; however, retired members shall be assessed an . 136649. 1

administration fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) annually.

- B. No person shall falsely represent himself to be an active member of <u>or retired from</u> the New Mexico national guard so as to be eligible to be issued special registration plates pursuant to this section when he in fact is not a current member of <u>or retired from</u> the New Mexico national guard.
- C. Any person who violates the provisions of Subsection B of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor."
