RELATI NG TO ELECTI ONS; PROVI DI NG FOR A SYSTEM TO ELECT PRESI DENTI AL ELECTORS; AMENDI NG A SECTI ON OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGI SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 1-15-4 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1969, Chapter 240, Section 354) is amended to read:
" 1-15-4. PRESI DENTI AL ELECTORS- - ELECTI ON. --
A. The names of the presidential elector nominees shall not be placed upon the general el ection ballot; instead, the secretary of state shall certify to the county clerks the names of persons nom nated by each qualified political party for the offices of president and vice president of the United St at es.
B. The names of [such] the nominees for presi dent and vice president for each qualified political party shall be . 136752. 1
printed toget her in pairs upon the general el ection ballot. A vote for any [such] pai $r$ of nomi nees shall be a vote for the presidential el ectors of the political party by which [such] the nomi nees were named.
[ C. The presidential elector nominees of the party Whose nominees for president and vice president recei ve the highest number of votes at the general election shall be the elected presidential electors for this state, and each-shal+ be granted a certificate of election by the state canvassing board.]
C. Begi nni ng in 2004, presidential el ectors shal I be el ected as follows:
(1) one presidential el ector shall be el ected from each congressional di strict and two shall be el ected at I arge;
(2) the at-l arge presidential el ector nomi nees of the party whose nomi nees for presi dent and vice presi dent recei ve the hi ghest number of votes statewi de in the general el ection shall be the el ected at-l arge presidential el ectors; and
(3) in each congressional di strict, the presi dential el ector nomi nee of the party whose nom nees for presi dent and vice president recei ve the hi ghest number of votes in that congressional district in the general el ection shall be the elected presidential el ector fromthat district. . 136752. 1
